PEACH PASS ALERTS CUSTOMERS OF PROBABLE EMAIL PHISHING SCAM

ATLANTA – The State Road and Tollway Authority is alerting Peach Pass customers about an email phishing scam being reported by customers. If you have received an email requesting you to **“Update your profile”** in the subject line or the body of the email, please **do not open** the email and **do not open** any links associated with the email. Please immediately delete the message from your inbox.

The email may also have the blue “State Road and Tollway Authority” logo positioned at the top of the email and include a hyperlink to “Update your profile.” This is a fraudulent email and is **NOT** an authorized communication from Peach Pass or the State Road and Tollway Authority. Instead, this email is likely part of a phishing scam that may look very similar to a legitimate email from Peach Pass or the State Road and Tollway Authority.
