GA 400 Toll Plaza Area Traffic To Shift To Permanent Lanes Configuration This Weekend

WHAT: Traffic moving through the area of the former Toll Plaza on Georgia (State Route) 400 will shift this weekend into its final and permanent configuration – three travel lanes in each direction. The lanes will be located on the inside (left) area of the roadway, that section formerly used by vehicles with Cruise Cards.

WHEN: The shift will occur over the span of two overnights, weather permitting. Northbound traffic will be shifted beginning at 10 p.m., Friday, September 5, with work extending into the early hours of Saturday morning. At 10 p.m., that night, Saturday, September 6, the southbound shift will begin.

WHERE: The former Georgia 400 Toll Plaza area, north of the route's Lenox Road interchange.

NOTE: **Motorists should slow down and proceed through the areas with extreme caution while the shift is taking place; delays are likely. In addition, they should continue to drive through the area carefully once the shift is complete as work will be ongoing to remove the unnecessary pavement to the right of the lanes.**
