

View "Real-Time" Express Lane Toll Rate Signs!

PeachPass.com is now your window into the I-85 Express Lanes. "Real-time" views of three Express Lane toll rate signs can be viewed through webcams that provide live streaming video, 24 hours a day.

Simply go to www.PeachPass.com and click on the sign location you want to view. The real-time toll rate sign you select will appear on screen. You'll also be able to toggle between all three cameras and sign views using the on-screen pull-down menu.

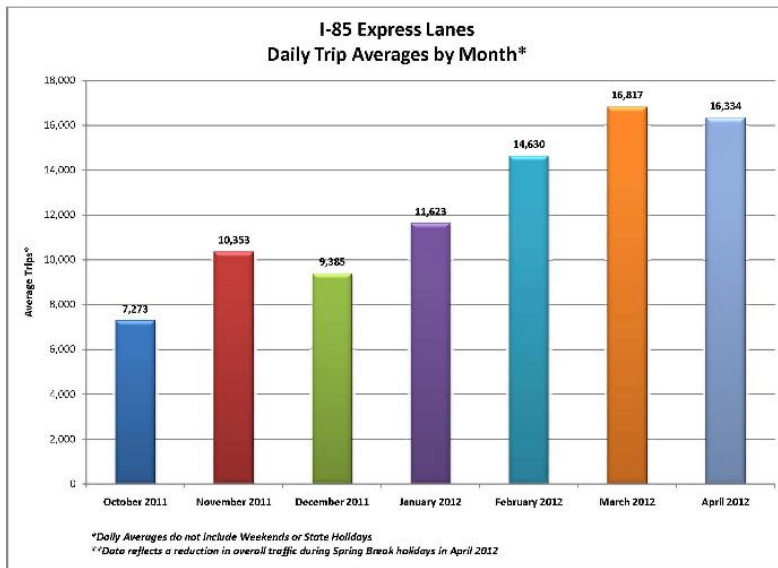
Work for GA 400 Improvement Projects Underway: MARTA Bridge and GA 400/I-85 Interchange



Soon MARTA transit riders will be able to enjoy a convenient walk across the pedestrian bridge at the MARTA Buckhead Station. Construction is underway as a series of weekly lane closures take place for initial construction and installation of bridge footings. In addition, construction is ongoing in development of the GA 400/I-85 Interchange to include installation of the barrier wall, signage and footings. Both projects are currently on schedule. 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increase in usage and provide more reliable trips for motorists who choose to use them. According to recent Express Lane usage data, motorists took an average of 16,000 trips per day in March 2012 and April 2012, more than twice the usage during the first month of operation in October 2011. In addition, over 160,000 Peach Pass transponders have been assigned for use in the I-85 Express Lanes and the all-electronic toll lanes on GA 400, and more than 71,000 different users have accessed the Express Lanes.

Commercial Accounts may include more than 10 vehicles/transponders.
