

With the new *Peach Pass Verify* Mobile App, you are just a few steps away from receiving free toll benefits when carpooling on the I-85 Express Lanes and I-85 Extension Express Lanes. Here's how to get started!

NOTE: You must be a Peach Pass customer to use *Peach Pass Verify*. Please be sure to have an active Peach Pass account, in good standing with a minimum balance of \$10, before attempting to set up a *Peach Pass Verify* account.

1 First, download the *Peach Pass Verify* Mobile App on the Apple or Google Play stores. Set up your account and be sure to allow the app to access your geo-location and send notifications about your trip.





Next, add each vehicle associated with your Peach Pass account that you may use to carpool along the I-85 Express Lanes and I-85 Extension Express Lanes within the settings menu, then return to the main app page.

Only one vehicle is required to use the **Peach Pass Verify** Mobile App. Additional vehicles may be added at any time within the settings menu.



After picking up your final person, open the app and make sure you have the correct vehicle selected. Click the **Start Carpool** button while your vehicle is still stationary and verify that there are at least three people in the vehicle. For driver safety, user features on the mobile app will be disabled while the vehicle is in motion.



Now you can set your phone down and enjoy the free toll benefits of carpooling along the I-85 Express Lanes and I-85 Extension Express Lanes! Peach Pass Verify will do the rest for you: the app will use your GPS signal to identify when you are within the Express Lane corridor. Just be sure to keep the app open in the background during your carpool trip ... you can still play music or use other apps as you commute.



Once you have arrived at your destination, open the *Peach Pass Verify* Mobile App and click the **End Carpool** button to reverify your trip. If you forget to do so – don't worry – the app will remind you!
